Functional


The Weather Pal we found at **Bailey's General Store** provides a charming way to measure how much rain has fallen. New Jersey-based Springfield Stoneworks has sculpted a smiling ceramic turtle, sitting up on a base of grass and holding an umbrella. Measuring about eight inches high, it features a rain gauge that uses the water it collects to magnify the readings.

It'll be difficult to misplace the tools made by Florals. Instead of being grass-green like most gardening tools, their handles are covered in colorful floral prints.
