## Surf's Up

Ben at **West Coast Surf Shop** showed us the latest in dual-use flip-flops from Reef. The women's version has a slide out flat holder for a room key, ID, and other small items. A Velcro strap keeps it tucked firmly in place while walking. Other styles have a bottle opener encased in an indentation underneath the arch, available in both men's and women's versions. Additional men's styles contain an actual flask in which to carry a few ounces of beverage beneath the heel. Some come with a fin key to tighten the cap, which doubles for surfboard fin use.
